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| AGE LIMITS | WAG - Senior Category (as per FIG Technical Regulations) MAG - Senior Category (as per FIG Technical Regulations) All gymnasts must have a valid FIG licence until the end of the event. |

| DEADLINES | Definitive registration: September 20 th , 2024 |

| ENTRY FEES | No Entry Fee will be applied for this event. |
| ACCREDITATION COMPETITION | All members will receive the accreditation card after arrival. The competition proceeds in 3 rounds: |
| FORMAT | The competition proceeds in 5 rounds. |
| | The first round - <u>gualification</u> : 12 pairs take part, every gymnast performs on two pieces of apparatus. |
| | The second round – <u>semi-finals</u>: 6 best-ranked pairs pass to the second round. In case of a tie for 6 th place, all the pairs for 6 th place will participate in the second round. The starting order of the pairs will be according to the results of the first round: the couple on the 6 th place shall start. In the semi-finals the gymnasts perform on one piece of apparatus which must be different from first round. The results of the first round are not carried forward to the second round - start from zero. |
| | The third round - <u>finals</u> : 4 best ranked pairs in the semi-finals pass to this final round. In case of a tie for 4 th place the couple with the better result in the qualification round will participate in the 3 rd round. If there is also a tie, the couple with the higher number of highest scores will participate in the 3 rd round. The starting order will be determined by drawing of lots. In the final the female and male gymnasts perform on any of the pieces of apparatus (they can repeat any of already used piece except apparatus from the second round). The results of the previous rounds are not carried forward to the 3 rd round - start from zero. The Grand Prix winner is the couple with the highest sum of scores in the third round. |
