	Gymnasts from FIG affiliated federations and clubs from those federations. If the entries are made by a club of these federations, the acceptance for participation of the respective national federation, according to the FIG rules, is needed. Please note that as per FIG regulations, junior gymnasts must be between 13 to 16 years old (between 2008 and 2011).

INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION	zones. The invited participating federations/clubs must pay for the travel costs of their delegation members. The Travel Schedule Form must be returned to the OC by 22 nd May 2024.	
LOCAL TRANSPORTATION	The organizing committee will provide organized transportation from Zurich Airport to Arosa and back to Zurich Airport. Cost per person is CHF 120 and must be added for all team members which require transportation.

For federations which wish to organize their own travel to Arosa please take note of the following restrictions for buses/coaches: the maximum width is 2,3m; maximum height is 4m; and the max. weight is 18 tons. Precise arrival and departure schedules for all team members must accompany the Nominative Entry. The deadline for non-reimbursement of the transportation costs is 5th June 2024 **ACCOMMODATION** Accommodation is offered in hotels and a low-cost option "Backpackers". Only a limited number of single and triple rooms are available. Reservations are made on first come first served basis. The Organizing Committee is reserving the right to change reservations into other room compositions, in which case the relevant Club/Federation will be informed. They will have to pay the additional costs. **Important note:** For lodging at the same hotels as the World Cup Competitors, the hotel prices are valid as announced in the "Directives" for the 2024 FIG World Cup Competition in Arosa. Please do not hesitate to contact the organizing committee in case of any questions. Accommodation prices include local public transport in Arosa, hotel, breakfast, and dinner ("Backpackers" Option: no dinner included). 4 Star Hotel (Option 1) The costs per person/night in this hotel are as follows: **CHF 196.-** single room (including breakfast, dinner, and banquet) CHF 160.- double room (including breakfast, dinner, and banquet) Triple rooms on request 3 Star Hotel (Option 2) The costs per person/night in this hotel are as follows: **CHF 171.-** single room (including breakfast, dinner, and banquet) **CHF 145.-** double room (including breakfast, dinner, and banquet) **CHF 135.-** triple room (including breakfast, dinner, and banquet) "Low-Cost Option" Backpacker's (Only a limited number of beds are available on request): CHF 70.- per person/night in double, triple, quadruple rooms all with shared bathrooms (including breakfast only).

All reservations must be made with the enclosed booking forms.

The prices charged for the hotel rooms will not exceed the usual hotel rates. While the Accommodation Form must be returned to the LOC by **17**th **April 2024** at the very latest, the Hotel rooms will be allocated on a "first come, first serve" basis.

The invited participating federations/clubs must pay for the accommodation expenses of their delegation members.

The costs for the accommodations must be paid to the LOC by 22nd May 2024

The accommodation is only refundable, provided cancellations are made at least prior to 5th June 2024.

MEALS

The above-mentioned accommodation prices include breakfast, dinner, and banquet.

The "low-cost hotel" option only includes breakfast (dinner and banquet can be ordered on special request to the OC).

Additional meals (lunch) can be ordered for CHF 25.- with the entry forms or can be bought at the accreditation desk after arrival.

The Meals Form must be returned to the LOC by **22nd May 2024** at the very latest and the costs for the meals must be paid to the LOC by **22nd May 2024**.
