2.2 Competition Format

The FIG requirements will be applied for all phases of competitions.

Event IDs: **Senior event ID – 17276 Junior event ID – 17290**

After the drawing of lots (which took place on February 29th) no individual gymnast can be added to the number of gymnasts declared in the definitive registration and no additional group can be registered.

For nominative changes, until fifteen (15) days prior to the start of the qualifications, federations are allowed to modify the composition of their delegation (Individual and/or group).

(Ref. FIG Technical Regulations - Section 3 - Art. 6 - Registration Changes)

2.2.1 Senior Individuals

Qualifying competition with Team ranking

- 1-3 gymnasts per NF
- The gymnasts present maximum 8 exercises with the apparatus according to the FIG programme for the respective year
- A gymnast may participate in 1 - 4 exercises
- If a NF participates with only 1 gymnast, she must present an exercise with all 4 apparatus
- NF with only 1 gymnast cannot participate in the Team ranking
- Qualification for the AA – the best 3 scores count (max. 2 gymnasts per NF).

2.2.2 All-Around final

- The best 24 gymnasts from the qualifications
- 1 gymnast from the host country if not yet qualified. The distribution of places will be as follows: 24+1 from the host country (if not qualified)
- The gymnasts must present 4 exercises
- Maximum 2 gymnasts per NF
- The All-Around ranking result is obtained by the best 4 scores
- The winner of the All-Around competition is awarded with the title "European All-Around Champion".

2.2.3 Apparatus Finals

- Competition of the best 8 individual gymnasts per apparatus of the qualifying competition. Maximum 2 per NF.
- The first ranked gymnast of each apparatus is awarded with the title "European Champion".

2.2.4 Senior Group All-Around – 5 Hoops and 3 Ribbons & 2 Balls

Qualifying competition with Team and All-Around ranking

- Group competition (5-6 gymnasts) with 2 different exercises, one executed with 1 apparatus, the other with 2 types of apparatus, according to the FIG programme for the respective year.
- The winner of the All-Around competition is awarded with the title "European All-Around Champion".
- The All-Around competition is also a qualifying competition for the Apparatus finals
- NF only with Senior Group cannot participate in the Team ranking

2.2.5 Senior Groups Apparatus Finals

- Competition of the best 8 groups per apparatus of the qualifying competition.
- The gymnasts of the first ranked group in the group exercises are awarded with the title "European Champion" at the respective apparatus.

2.2.6 Team ranking Senior Groups & Senior Individuals

- Senior Groups and Senior Individuals
- The winner of the Team Competition is designated as follows:
- Senior Individual gymnasts: the result of all 8 routines
- Senior Groups: the result of the 2 exercises.
- The above-mentioned results will be added; the best NF is awarded with the title “European Team Champion”.
- If a NF does not participate in the Team Competition (i.e. competes without a Senior Group): the gymnast/s can be ranked for the All-Around competition and qualify for the Apparatus Finals.
- If a NF does not participate in the Team Competition (i.e. competes without Senior Individuals): the Senior Group will be ranked for the All-Around competition and can qualify for the Apparatus Finals.



A Federation participating with only one Senior individual gymnast cannot be classified as a team, even if this Federation participates with a group.

2.2.7 Junior Individuals (Hoop – Ball – Clubs – Ribbon)

Qualifying competition with Team ranking

- Individual competition with 1 - 4 gymnasts per federation
- The gymnasts present 4 exercises with the 4 apparatus according to the FIG programme for the respective year.
- A gymnast may participate with 1 - 4 exercises
- If a NF participates with only 1 gymnast, she has to present an exercise with all 4 apparatus and can qualify with each apparatus for the Apparatus Finals.
- Team ranking: The result of all 4 scores
- The first ranked Junior Team will be awarded with the title “European Junior Team Champion”.
- NF with only 1 gymnast cannot participate in the Team ranking.

2.2.8 Junior Individuals Apparatus Finals

- Competition of the best 8 gymnasts per apparatus (4 apparatus) of the qualifying competition. Maximum 1 per NF
- The first ranked gymnast of each apparatus is awarded with the title “European Junior Champion”.

2.3 Olympic qualification

For information regarding the Paris 2024 Olympic Qualification System please refer to the document [“Olympic Qualification System Paris 2024 RG” published on the FIG website.](#)

The Olympic qualification for individual gymnasts will take place in the **individual all-around qualification competition on May 23 + May 24, based on 4 scores**. **Gymnasts wanting to participate in the Olympic qualification must compete in all 4 routines.**

The **Olympic qualification for groups** will take place in the **groups all-around competition on May 25**. Olympic qualification competitions for European Gymnastics and Oceania Gymnastics Union take place separately.

2.4 Tie break rules

In case of a tie at any position at the end of any competition, the tie breaking rules set out in the TR FIG will apply (TR FIG, Section 3, Article 7).

2.5 Changes of the Starting Order

Between the nominative registration – Step 2 and the accreditation

The injured or sick gymnast can be replaced and another gymnast can be accredited.

Between the Accreditation and 24 hours before the start of the Qualifications

The injured or sick gymnast can be replaced. The injured or sick gymnast must return her accreditation and another gymnast can be accredited. Gymnasts who have been withdrawn or replaced for whatever reason (including injuries and illness), may at no time be reaccredited.

Less than 24 hours before the start of the Qualifications

No new accreditations can be delivered. If the Qualifications take place over more than one day, the start time of the day of Qualifications in which an Individual gymnast or Group is scheduled to compete is used to calculate the 24 hours before. The injured or sick gymnast can be replaced by any gymnast already accredited, except those withdrawn or replaced, only with medical certificate verified by the official European Gymnastics / LOC medical doctor. In the above cases, the replacing Individual gymnast will have to perform all apparatus the sick or injured gymnast was registered for, and will fill the same position(s) in the draw (starting order) of the replaced gymnast.

For **changes less than 24 hours prior to the start of the competition**, the subsequent regulations in the FIG TR will apply.

Special Provisions

Each federation may enter 5 or 6 gymnasts for the total programme of group exercises (2 in qualifications and 2 finals if qualified). In case of 6 gymnasts, all 6 gymnasts must take part in at least one exercise. Should one gymnast not take part in any exercise, the group is disqualified. In case of 6 gymnasts the group composition must be submitted for both exercises at the time of the nominative registration. The identity of each gymnast will be checked before entering the competition floor for both exercises. The coach will be informed should the group composition not correspond to the one submitted. He/she will be given the possibility to modify the group composition to be in accordance with the one declared. Should the coach let his/her group compete with a different composition will result in the disqualification of his/her group from the respective exercise(s). As a result, the group will not be ranked in the All-Around Ranking List nor in the Ranking List of the routine it was disqualified from. Modifications of the group composition can be accepted on site only with a medical certificate verified by the official FIG doctor.

Each group exercise has to be performed by 5 gymnasts. A group comprising a different number of gymnasts is not acceptable.

2.6 Access to the competition area

Concerning the presence of the coaches and medical staff on the Field of Play (FoP), the provisions listed in the below table will apply.

(Federations who registered only one coach will receive only 1 TAC for the competition concerned.)

2.7 Use of electronic devices (TR European Gymnastics)

During the duration of official European Gymnastics competitions (which is defined as starting the moment the first gymnast enters the field of play and ending the moment the last score is publicly displayed):

- Judges on the field of play are absolutely prohibited from using mobile phones / tablets and any other kind of electronic communication devices.
- Other delegation members (gymnasts, coaches, medical staff) are prohibited from using mobile phones and any other kind of electronic communication devices. However, gymnasts are allowed to listen to music (with earphones and on a sound level which is not observable for surrounding persons). It is also allowed to other delegation members to take photos (but no videos), without flash and not interrupting the running of the competition.
- If these rules are violated, the persons concerned will receive a verbal warning.
- If this behaviour is repeated after a written warning is issued, those persons concerned will be excluded for the rest of the competition.
- The Superior Jury is responsible for deciding these disciplinary measures.
- Appeals against these decisions have to be submitted to the Jury of Appeal whose decision is final.

2.8 Ceremonies and Awarding

2.8.1 Award ceremonies

All award ceremonies will take place after each block of finals. It will be carried out in accordance with the European Gymnastics Directives for Ceremonies. On the podium, awards will only be presented to the gymnasts ranked from 1st to 3rd place.

- For the team award ceremonies, **1** coach is allowed on the podium.
- Please ensure that your Federation's medallists are in time for the line-up prior to the ceremonies.
- **All gymnasts & coaches must wear the official tracksuit.**
- The participation of the medallists in the award ceremonies is compulsory. All gymnasts that are absent for unjustified reasons will be disqualified.

2.8.2 Opening Ceremony

The opening ceremony will take place on Friday, May 24th at 16:15 in the Sportarena.

2.8.3 SmartScoring Shooting Star Award

On **Sunday, May 26th**, after the senior individual all-around final, European Gymnastics Global Partner SmartScoring will hand over the Shooting Star Awards to one senior gymnast of these European Championships.

Started in 2018, this award aims to put gymnasts with an exceptional story in the spotlight as an inspiration for the future generation of gymnasts and the general public alike. The winners will be chosen by a selection committee consisting of representatives from SmartScoring and European Gymnastics authorities and staff.

2.8.4 LOC Nominations / Awarding – “Miss Press”

The presentation of the award will take place at 15:40 on 26 May, 2024.

Flyers will be distributed among the media representatives. They will indicate on it the name of their

favourite gymnast for this award and the flyer should be put into the box that will be located into the Press Centre. The voting will start from 22 May 2024 until 25 May 2024 during the competition.

2.9 Apparatus

The apparatus supplier of this edition of the European Championships is Gymnova (colour: beige). A total of 15 carpets + additional stretching area will be available.

2.10 Scoring and distribution of results

For each competition, start lists and results will be provided on www.europeangymnastics.com. In addition, they will be sent to the heads of delegation by e-mail. At the end of the championships all delegations will be provided with a complete set of results including the judges' individual scores for all competitions.

2.11 Control of the Apparatus

All hand apparatus must be FIG certified and must respect the dimensions of the FIG Apparatus Norms. According to the TR FIG, an apparatus control will take place before the competition. A draw will be conducted to decide the gymnasts whose apparatus will be controlled. If one of your gymnasts has been drawn, you will get a notification in your delegation box.

- During the training sessions in the competition hall, each delegation will have the opportunity to have its apparatus verified and have the official control label attached to it.
- During the competition, a control will be carried out before each exercise.
- A further check may take place at the end of the exercise at the request of the control judges or the superior jury.
- Any apparatus which is not according to the regulations will be refused or its use will be penalised (even if that apparatus had been accepted for a prior competition).

2.12 Music

The music has to be uploaded on the LOC Digital Platform; the login information has been sent to each federation after the definitive deadline. Delegation must upload their music not later than **April 22nd**.

- Music has to be uploaded in .mp3 format and named as follow:
 - o The name of the nation (official abbreviation of the country)
 - o The first and last name of the individual competitor or the group
 - o The apparatus
 - o The indication junior or senior
 - o Example: ROU_RADU_Alina_JUN.mp3 or HUN_Group_5hoos_SEN)
- Delegation members are requested to keep in their possession a copy on a USB key in case of a technical problem.
- At the accreditation, a form with the duration and the author of the music has to be filled in and handed in; official titles/interpreters have to be indicated (appendices 2 & 3).
- The authorised sound level in the training and competition halls is limited to 80 dB resp. 1000 Hertz (Hz).

2.13 Anti-doping controls

Any doping is prohibited. An anti-doping control can be requested at any time. Anti-doping controls will be made as per regulations of FIG and WADA.

THE JURY

3.1 Judges' panels

Each NF taking part must present one RGI qualified judge (cat. 1, 2 or 3) in good standing. The selection of the judges is made by draw during the Judges' instruction and the judges' meetings prior to each competition as follows:

- The D Judges are drawn by NF among the judges with cat. 1 or 2 (preference is given to the judges with cat. 1).
- A, E, T, L and Reserve Judges are drawn among the judges' cat. 1, 2 or 3 (preference is given to the judges with the highest qualification).

In Apparatus Finals, only judges whose NFs do not have competitors, nor a No 1 reserve gymnast taking part, may be called upon to judge. The selection is made by draw.

If there are insufficient number of judges, the TC decides the process for designating the necessary number of judges.

3.2 Superior Jury

The TC President Ms. Evangelia Trikomiti functions as President of the Superior Jury. The TC member Elena Aliprandi functions as assistant.

- Wednesday – Junior Individuals competition and Junior Individuals Finals, the Superior jury is composed of the Superior Jury + 2 Invited judges
- Thursday and Friday – Senior Individuals qualification competitions the Superior jury is composed of the Superior Jury + 2 Invited judges
- Saturday – Senior Individuals and Senior Groups AA competitions, the Superior jury is composed of the Superior Jury + 2 Invited judges
- Sunday – Senior Individuals Finals and Senior Groups Finals, the Superior jury is composed of the Superior Jury + 2 Invited judges

3.3 Jury of Appeal

The Jury of Appeal is composed of 2 members of European Gymnastics Executive Committee (one of them acting as President) and a member of the LOC who was not involved in the decision of the Superior Jury and in the judging process of the apparatus concerned.

3.4 Drawing of Lots of the Judges

All judges have to be present during all competition phases they are registered in.

3.5 Judges' instruction

All accredited Judges should study STS WCUP 2024 before they arrive.

Judges Instructions will take place on May 14th 10:00-13:00 CET online in a Zoom Meeting.

Attendance is compulsory and will be checked by the European Gymnastics RG TC. Judges who do not participate will not be authorized to judge at the European Championships.

The link to register will be sent by e-mail from European Gymnastics to all registered judges and to their respective NF. Each NF is requested to make sure their judge(s) are registered to this instruction.

Judges' practice VIDEOS will be sent to all NF and to all participating judges by e-mail. The judges are asked to download the video folder to their own computer and judge all the exercises according to the sub-folders in which they are placed.

Judges' Meetings, Briefings and Draw

All the judges are required to take part in the judges' briefings, draws and subsequent meetings (if any) in Budapest. Judges who do not participate will not be authorized to judge and will receive warnings and possibly other sanctions as well.

3.6 Code of Ethics

Any close family relative to a competitive gymnast may not judge that gymnast or this group at this FIG sanctioned event. If a conflict should or could appear, the European Gymnastics President is to be informed, so appropriate action can be taken.

3.7 Inquiries of the Score

- European Gymnastics applies the relevant FIG TR article in which the detailed procedure is laid down.
- If an inquiry is refused, the amount will be invoiced by European Gymnastics (in Euro, not in USD) and must be paid within one month upon receipt of the invoice.

Accredited Delegation members (with the exception of E- and R- media), who stay at one of the official hotels and book their accommodation through the LOC will receive a free ticket for the Farewell Banquet. The Farewell Banquet will take place at Europa Boat.

4.5 Training Information

The training takes place at the times published in this workplan. A detailed training schedule will be provided to the participating National Federations.

The delegations are obliged to respect the training schedules.

Access to the training halls is limited to the nations concerned and persons having the according accreditations.

After the official training in the competition hall, the Heads of Delegation have to confirm with a form (appendix 2), that the music tracks of their gymnasts are correct.

The official trainings start from May 21st. If any delegation needs training on non-official days (early trainings), the LOC can provide it at extra cost.


