In case of a tie in ranks in the Apparatus World Cup Ranking List concerned, the

- tie will be broken by respecting the following criteria:

 a. The ranks of the max. four (4) counting exercises will be added and the gymnast with the lowest total prevails.
 - Note: in case of a tie in the ranks to determine the four (4) counting exercises, the exercises with the highest final scores will prevail.
 - b. If the tie remains, the final scores of the max. four (4) counting exercises will be averaged and the gymnast with the highest average prevails.
