European Gymnastics is pleased to herein provide you with the Directives for the 13th European Age Group Competitions in Acrobatic Gymnastics to be held in Luxembourg (LUX) from April 10th – 13th, 2025.

These European Championships will be organised according to the FIG & European Gymnastics Statutes and Technical Regulations (TR), ACRO Code of Points and relevant newsletters, FIG Code of Ethics, FIG Code of Conduct, FIG Code of Discipline, FIG General Judges Rules, FIG Specific Judges Rules, FIG Anti-Doping Rules, European Gymnastics Medical Guidelines, the Medical Organisation of FIG Competitions and Events, the FIG Framework for safeguarding athletes and other participants from harassment and abuse in sport during events, the FIG Licence Rules, European Gymnastics Media Rules, FIG Apparatus Norms, FIG Advertising and Publicity Rules, FIG Rules for Sanctioning (approval) of International Events and European Gymnastics Accreditation Directives, as well as all other Rules and Guidelines valid starting 01 January 2025 onwards, any possible amendments by the date of these European Age Group Competitions, and any complements decided in the meantime.

All participating Federations commit to abide by the Statutes and all European Gymnastics & FIG Rules and Regulations. Federations that fail to respect them will not be allowed to participate.

5. PARTICIPATION RIGHT AND ACCREDITATIONS

Gymnasts holding a valid FIG licence until the end of the competitions, and with the correct age from European Gymnastics and FIG affiliated Federations in good standings, may take part in these European Championships. An individual is entitled to only one accreditation card. If an individual has several valid "accreditable functions", the highest function is normally selected and the access zones of the functions are cumulated. No substitutes may directly benefit from unused accreditations.

The functions of judge and gymnast cannot be combined with any other function.

Accreditation Application Process

Accreditation cards will be distributed at the Accreditation Centre situated at Competition Venue upon arrival of the delegations.

The following items will be checked there with the Heads of delegations:

- Passports of all members of the delegations
- Transport – Departure
- The medical insurance for the members of the delegations, except from the gymnasts and judges, see point 18.
- Prove of the fulfilment of all financial obligations to the LOC
- Check of national anthem and national flag

In order to accelerate the process of the accreditation, each participating Federation is kindly requested to upload photos and passport copy of each member of its delegation (gymnasts, head of delegation, team leaders, coaches, judges, doctor, physiotherapist) into the LOC digital platform. The deadline for the photos and passport copies upload (identity colour photo in JPG format, size – 45 mm x 35 mm, resolution: 800x600 pixels) **by March 10th, 2025**. Please clearly indicate the corresponding full name (with correct spelling) in the file title. Submission of photos in due time will prevent the delegations from waiting at the accreditation Centre. 50 EUR will be charged for each photo the LOC has to make at the arrival of the delegation.

The European Gymnastics Accreditation Rules and Media Rules have to be strictly respected.

6. AGE LIMIT OF GYMNASTS & CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

Pre-Youth **11 – 16 years (born 2009 – 2014)**

Youth **12 – 18 years (born 2007 – 2013)**

A "unit" without any changes, who has competed in any FIG approved competition, cannot participate in a "lower age group").

A gymnast may only participate in one Age Group and unit (pair/group) during same competition (EAGC). Individuals who have competed as Seniors, but who are in newly formed age group pairs or groups are eligible.

A gymnast can move down in age groups, only if he/she belongs to a different unit* (pair/group).

* Is considered a different unit when minimum one partner changes in a pair/group.

7. REGISTRATIONS AND ENTRY FEES

Registrations can only be made by European Gymnastics and FIG affiliated federations in good standing, via the **GymData** Online registration tool from Smart Scoring (<https://registry.gymdata.online/>) and by using the National Gymnastics Federations' login and password.

Definitive Registration

The definitive registrations must be completed by entering the composition of the delegation until **Thursday, January 16th, 2025** (23:59 Swiss time) at the very latest.

Nominative Registrations

The nominative registrations must be completed by entering the names of the delegation until **Monday, March 10th, 2025** (23:59 Swiss time) at the very latest.

Entry Fees EUR 150.- per gymnast

The total amount of the entry fees must be paid until the date of the nominative registration deadline, **Monday, March 10th, 2025 at the very latest on European Gymnastics bank account.**

European Gymnastics fines

The fines after missing the Registrations deadlines or after late Registrations are as follows (as per the European Gymnastics Technical Regulations, Art. 3.2.5):

8. LICENCES

No gymnasts will be accredited without a FIG licence valid until the end of the competitions.

In order to be considered, Licence application forms (new or renewal) must be submitted to the FIG at least one (1) month prior to the deadline for nominative registration.

9. JUDGES AND JURY OF APPEAL

Judges

All judges must have a current valid FIG brevet at the time of the event.

Each delegation is entitled to present one or two category 1, 2, 3 or 4 judges excluding any appointed difficulty or chair judges until the end of the event. In the draw, the priority may be given to the judges with the high categories.

Federations with international brevet judges are obliged to present a minimum of one judge except for new countries who are in the first cycle of participating.

All judges will be given the opportunity to officiate in at least one event. The selection of judges (draw) is made by the European Gymnastics TC-ACRO. The judges must be eligible to judge in the respective function. The Chairs of Judges Panel and the difficulty judges (totally or partially) are appointed by the European Gymnastics TC-ACRO. All judges must participate in the judges' instruction meeting. The costs for the judges will be at the charge of their respective federations.

- **If a federation does not enter a judge, European Gymnastics will request payment of the amount indicated in the below list:**

Judges shall recuse themselves if

- They are or were married to or live in a registered partnership or co-habit with a gymnast
- They are related to a gymnast by birth or marriage in direct or in collateral line, including the following persons: grandparent, parent, uncle, aunt, brother, sister, child, grandchild, nephew and cousin.

Jury of Appeal and Supervisory Board

No jury of appeal will be assigned for the European Age Groups Competition. The decision of the president of the Superior Jury is final.

10. DRAWING OF LOTS

The gymnasts' drawing of lots will decide the starting order of the qualification competitions and the finals. It will take place on **February, 21st 2025**.

No registrations can be accepted after the drawing of lots.

11. COMPETITION FORMAT AND PROGRAMME

See the current European Gymnastics & FIG Technical Regulations, FIG Code of Points and FIG Acrobatic Gymnastics Youth and Juniors rules.

In Pre-Youth (11-16), the exercise to be presented in the final is pre-determined per category in accordance with the Pre-Youth rules for the current year (2025):

13. VISA

Please verify immediately with your travel agent or Embassy or Consulate of Luxembourg in your country if a visa is required for your travel to Luxembourg. The LOC will assist you with a visa support letter provided that the request is made to the LOC digital platform by March 10th, 2025 at the latest.

The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates of the Delegation Member as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to.

14. TRANSPORTATION

International Transportation

The invited participating Federations must pay for the travel costs of their delegation members to any of the official arrival locations. The official arrival locations are: Luxembourg International Airport - Findel (LUX).

The travel details must be submitted to the LOC digital platform until March 10th, 2025. The LOC will provide transfer from LUX-Airport (LUX) to hotels. Cost for transfer is included for all delegations who have booked their accommodation through the LOC.

Local Transportation

Since March 1st, 2022, public transport in Luxembourg is free throughout the country and for all modes of transport - trams, trains and buses. The scheme applies to all participating teams, as well as supporters that will come to Luxembourg to see the event on-site. The LOC will organize shuttle buses for the official hotels considered not to be located on the tram line, to the competition venue and back for delegations that are staying in those hotels and have booked accommodation through the LOC. The rest of the hotels are all located near the tram line which runs every 4 to 7 minutes from 5:30am to 00:30 am daily. The LOC will organize buses for/from farewell banquet for the delegations concerned as well.

The Accommodation Request must be submitted on the LOC digital platform no later than **Thursday, January 16th, 2025**.

The hotel rooms will be allocated on a “*first come, first serve*” basis, as the number of rooms are limited at each hotel. The LOC reserves the right to reallocate some delegations in same hotel categories in order to not divide any delegations.

The rooming list shall be submitted to the LOC digital platform no later than **Monday, March 10th, 2025**. Details will be communicated by the LOC directly to NF.

16. MEALS

Breakfast is included in the price of each room. The meal plan (lunch and dinner) is not compulsory and the delegations are free to make their own meals arrangements.

Meals Bookings

Breakfast will be served at the hotels (the price is included in the cost of each BB hotel booking) and HB (lunch) and FB (lunch + dinner) will be served at competition venue.

The LOC proposes the following options for having extra meals at the competition venue.

The Meal Request must be submitted to the LOC digital platform **by March 10th, 2025**, at the very latest.

Farewell Banquet

Accredited Delegation members (with the exception of E- and R- media), who book their accommodation through the LOC (minimum 6 nights) will receive a free ticket for the Farewell Banquet.

Tickets for the banquet for Accredited Delegation members not booking their accommodation through the LOC can be purchased for EUR 90 per person, provided that a request is submitted on the LOC mail address contact@acroluxembourg2025.lu **by March 10th, 2025**, at the very latest.

17. FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS – PAYMENT

Payments to European Gymnastics:

The non-reimbursable registration fee of **EUR 150.-** per gymnast must be paid to the European Gymnastics.

Registrations without the appropriate payment of the registration fee at the time of the Nominative Registration (funds received by the European Gymnastics) will be considered invalid (i.e. the athletes will not be allowed to compete).

Federations which have not fulfilled their financial obligations towards the European Gymnastics & FIG are not be allowed to participate in these European Age Group Competitions either.

Each participating member Federation is kindly requested to clearly state payment’s purpose as follows:

The participating federation is responsible for covering all bank fees in connection with the bank transfers. Please state the name of your Federation and the payment purpose on the transfer. The payment must be made in EUR only.

Payment deadlines:

- The first 50% of the total accommodation/meals costs – by **January, 16th 2025**
- Settlement of the remaining 50% of accommodation/meals costs – by **March 10th, 2025**

Cancellation Policy for Accommodation and Meals

European Gymnastics and the LOC strongly recommend that each Federation take a cancellation insurance for their travel, accommodations and meal options.

Accommodation and Meals:

- From January 17th to February 9th: 50% of the total accommodation/meals cost will be charged
- After February 9th: 100% cancellation fee of the total accommodation/meals cost will be applied

18. INSURANCE

The Host Federation, the Organizing Committee, European Gymnastics and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like. The European Gymnastics and FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.

The FIG insurance IMSSA (International Medical & Security Sports Assistance) for **gymnasts and judges** with a valid FIG Licence / Brevet is valid for these European Championships. Basic insurance (sickness, accident and repatriation) in your country of residence is compulsory in order to be able to benefit from coverage by FIG IMSSA subsidiary insurance. Please also refer to <https://www.gymnastics.sport/site/pages/medical-insurance.php> for additional information regarding the FIG IMSSA insurance for Athletes and Judges. **All**

other delegation members are NOT included in this insurance and must present a proof of insurance at the accreditation.

The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy in English writing). Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the LOC in advance.

The LOC will subsequently offer insurance at the Federations' own charge as follows: 50 EUR per person and per day for the duration of the event.

19. WORK PLAN

The Workplan will be published on the European Gymnastics website six weeks before the start of the competitions.

20. OFFICIAL HOSPITAL

The Official hospital will be the **Centre Hospitalier de la Ville de Luxembourg**. The full details will be known later.

The name of the Medical Doctor will be communicated in the Work Plan.

This official hospital as well as the medical personnel assigned duly accept the International SOS (IMSSA insurance card) for all athletes holding a valid FIG Licence as well as for all judges with an International FIG Judges Brevet valid at the time of these European Age Group Competitions.

The medical team present at the venue during the competition will undertake all necessary steps for guaranteeing the best possible follow-up in case of injury/accident.

21. SAFEGUARDING

A safe environment for all participants is a top priority at the 2025 European Championships.

22. DOPING CONTROLS

Under the supervision of the International Testing Agency, anti-doping controls will be organized according to the valid WADA Code, International Standards and FIG Anti-Doping Rules. The anti-doping controls may take place at any time. The following tests will be run: standard controls (urine), standard control(s) + ESA, standard control(s) + GHRF, standard control(s) + GH (blood).

23. TARIFF SHEETS, MUSIC AND MUSIC FORMS

The tariff sheets and the music must be uploaded to the AcroCompanion platform. Further details will be in the Work Plan.

Music files have to be uploaded in mp3 format.

Delegation members are requested to keep in their possession a specimen of their USB key for their training sessions and in case of a technical problem.

Each Federation will also have to confirm that the music used does not violate any copyrights and that it can be broadcasted within sports.

At the accreditation, the Heads of delegation have to hand in the Music Release form which you will receive together with the work plan.
